3. Thinking about Sunday's message, what was the most impactful thing that you learned? Why?
4. A wise man once said "Faith trusts, and reason believes." Based on that idea and what Pastor Randy said about faith and trust described in Hebrews 11:6, How would you describe the relationship between faith and trust in your own words?
5. Read Romans 10:8b-14 where Paul explains the relationship between faith, trust, and belief.
 - a) What is the theme Paul is talking about in this passage?
 - b) If trust is faith in action, where do we see trust described in this section?
 - c) What must come before trust? (verse 14)
 - d) What is the result of trust that comes from belief (faith)? (verse 13)
 - f) What is the promise made to those who trust in God?
 - g) What does it mean to "never be disgraced"?

h) Do you think it is possible to trust in something you don't have faith in? or have faith in something you don't trust? Why?

6. Who is one of the people you trust the most? What do you know about that person that fuels that trust?

7. What areas do you have the most trouble trusting God? What prevents you from relying on God in those areas?
