"What do you mean, 'What's the matter?'" Micah replied. "You've taken away all the gods I have made, and my priest, and I have nothing left!" - Judges 18:24 (NLT)

2. _____

Then, with Micah's idols and his priest, the men of Dan came to the town of Laish, whose people were peaceful and secure. They attacked with swords and burned the town to the ground. - Judges 18:27 (NLT)

3. _____

Then they set up the carved image, and they appointed Jonathan son of Gershom, son of Moses, as their priest. This family continued as priests for the tribe of Dan until the Exile. ³¹ So Micah's carved image was worshiped by the tribe of Dan as long as the Tabernacle of God remained at Shiloh. - Judges 18:30-31 (NLT)
