In the line up for iServe 2019 we have several returning speakers and several who will be with us for the first time. Below is a list of the workshop leaders along with a brief bio.



Anne "Annie" Hubach is a pastoral counselor in a church-sponsored ministry in Bedford, Virginia. She has her M.A. in Human Services Counseling as well as a B.A. in Spanish and Education. She is a certified teacher (K-12) and marriage counselor (SYMBIS and Prepare and Enrich) and is currently in the doctoral program for Community Care and Counseling at Liberty University with a focus on marriage and family counseling. Hubach is the mother of five, including a son with severe intellectual disabilities, and is a proud grandmother. Hubach was a missionary to Bolivia where she coached a national volleyball team and taught English. She has been an educator for 35 years as well as a Bible teacher, volleyball coach and swim coach.



Matt Walton has been involved with youth & children's ministry for more than two decades. He earned a Master's of Christian Education from Campbell University Divinity School in Buies Creek, North Carolina in 2000. Matt has served churches in various capacities ranging from a Sunday school teacher to a full-time youth and children's minister. In 2012 Matt and his wife Stacey moved to Hawaii to serve with Child Evangelism Fellowship of Hawaii. From day one, Matt & Stacey have felt at home in Hawaii. Matt works to train children's ministry leaders and coordinate Bible based clubs for children in public schools throughout Oahu and now right here on Molokai.
